## Omnipresence:

Present everywhere at the same time. God's  
all presents, as He is and always will be.

He fills the space of all that exist and yet to  
exist. Jeremiah 23:23-24 "Am I a God near,"  
the Ever-Living asks, "and not a God at a  
distance? 24) If a man hides himself in  
shelters, cannot I see him?" asks the Ever-  
Living. "Are not the heavens and the breath  
of earth Mine?" says the Ever-Living.

When the earth was young and no man had  
yet walked upon Her face He was there.  
Before a creature was created He was there.  
He filled the Heavens before the heavens  
were there.  
Neither rock nor stone is without His  
presence.  
Neither tree that stands nor blade of grass  
can survive without His presence.

His Spirit fills the air that all breath either under the sea or that which lives above. For the Ever-Living is like a fire consuming all that was or is not.

Amos 9:2-3 And if they dig down to the Graves-  
Then My Hand can take them from there!  
Or if they mount up to the skies,  
From there I can bring them down  
3) And if they should hide upon Karmel,  
I will search and will catch them there, -  
If they hide from my eyes in the south,  
To the depths of the sea I will go! -

Where is God and how do we know He exists?  
Do you remember the song, "Because the Bible told me so."

John 1:1-5 The Word existed in the beginning, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2) He was present with God at the beginning. 3) All came into existence by means of Him. 4) What originated in Him was life; and the Life was the Light of Mankind. 5) That Light shines in the darkness; but darkness did not absorb it.

His presence was felt through miracles and wonders in the Old Testament but then they did not know Him as we do. The Spirit of the Lord filled their bodies and gave them life. But they did not know Him. He walked among them when He choose to and came upon them and they received great powers. But still they did not know Him. He allowed David to kill the lion, bear and even mighty men. But only David knew His presents.

He came to Abram and asked for his son because He knew one day He would sacrifice His Own Flesh for us. He made stone produce water; sticks turn into snakes, brought upon floods and His presence was feared.

He told us in John 3:3 "Most assuredly I tell you," replied Jesus, "that unless anyone is born from above, he cannot see the Kingdom

of God."

I know Jesus for He walked then in their presence and He walks now in ours.

Colossians 1:16-20 " because by him was created everything in the heavens and upon the earth - the seen and the unseen; whether thrones, sovereignties, governments, or authorities - the whole were created through Him and for Him, 17) and he Himself preceded all, and the whole was established by Him. 18) And He is the Head of the body, the church; He is the Beginning, the bringer-forth from the dead, so that He may Himself be the first over all. 19 - Because He decreed that all perfection should dwell in Him; 20) and through Him He collect all again to Himself - having made peace by the blood of His cross, through Him - whether upon the earth or in the heavens.

His loving arms surround all; but those who believe feel His Loving Grace. John 12:38 "so that the word of Isaiah the prophet might be verified, which said: LORD WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR STATEMENT, AND TO WHOM WAS THE ARM OF THE LORD REVEALED?"

In His presence all creation stand, none alone but each on there own. For the Godhead allowed His presence to be seen through the Son and when He departed Grace befell upon us and we walk with Him as no one has done before. Awaken the unction of the sleeping Spirit of the Lord for Grace dwells within us for He said He must go so that the Comforter may come.

For thousand of years man did not know His full presence and now many forget, His death was to allow us to live a life of perfection and love in grace. We search the scripture for the truth. We go to assemblies to hear the Word while all along He is present within our body and soul. He did not die to punish us or to leave, but His death was so we can feel Him morning, noon and night. The loving Grace of the Holy Spirit a Nature of God's

presence indwells within us. We give Him thanks for it is our praise that makes His Spirit known to us. Acts 17:23-28 - "What, therefore, you unknowingly worship, I proclaim to you. 24) The God, Who made the Universe and all in it, Who, being Himself Lord of heaven and earth, resides not in temples made of hands, 25) nor is served by hands of men, as though needing anything: Himself giving to every one life and breath and all things; 26) because He made by One every race of men to dwell upon the whole face of the earth, having provided proper methods and guides for their research in seeking God -27) if only they feel for and find Him - and yet He is certainly not far from every one of us; 28) for from Him we live, and move, and exist;-"

Since God is present in all of His creation what can contain Him? 1 King 8:27 "But will God really dwell upon the earth, while the heaven, and the heaven of heavens are not able to contain Him? - then how can this House which I have built?"

David realized that it was not enough just to build a temple, not just enough to lay bricks and stones for God to live in and through His creation. David went on to write 1 King 8:28 "Therefore turn to prayer of your servant, Living God, to listen to his cry, and the prayer which Your servant prays before You to-day."

David knew that he did not need to go anywhere to pray to the Ever-Living for the Ever-Living was everywhere. And yet three thousand years after he wrote this and two thousand years after the death and resurrection of Jesus many only pray when they go to a so-called church or assemble. David at the time of his writings did not have the indwelling of the Holy Spirit yet he knew the presence of God because he prayed continuously. Paul wrote (KJV) Romans 12:12 "Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer." Paul understood the only way was through prayer, yet

ministries call special prayer days, individuals feel a need to share in prayer once or twice a week, rather than being in prayer at all times.

Jesus before His death left us a message in John 14:15-17, "If you love Me, keep my commands, 16) and I will ask the Father, and he will send you another Helper, to continue with you for ever - 17) the Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. You will know Him, however, for he will remain with you, and will be in you."

Why then are we confused? We are in Him and He in us. There is not a place on earth or in the heavens where God does not exist. When you are alone He is there. When you are sick He is there. When you have a need He is there. Many go hungry, many die from illness and He is there. From the richest county to the poorest nation God is there. He said John 9:3 "Neither did this man sin, nor his parents," replied Jesus; "but he is so, in order that the working of God may be displayed through him." Do you know that your works are to teach the Word of God? His presences in you are so that you can continue in Him.

Acts 13:47 "for thus the Lord commanded us: I HAVE PLACED YOU AS A LIGHT FOR THE HEATHEN, THAT YOU SHOULD CARRY SALVATION TO THE BOUNDS OF THE EARTH."
